1. LogIS Strategy

This has been drafted and sets out the approach to Defence Support Network IS. The document is with Maj Gen Fay for review, prior to circulation.

Recommend: At 8 Sep meeting with Maj Gen Fay, Team Defence Information suggest a workshop in Sep 17 to review and comment on draft with attendance from the JIG and DISCOG members. This would be similar to the review carried out of the Defence Information Strategy for ISS, with the goal of providing useful input and feedback.

2. Information Enablers Work Strand

5 capability investigations are in development for the Information Enablers work strand of the Defence Support Network Transformation programme. The capability investigations are planned to be released via the Digital Outcomes 2 framework, with an expected start in Oct 17. Project Initiation Documents have been shared with the DSN PMO (Tony Doherty) and the investigations will be informed by the Log IS Strategy and build on the Government Digital Services approach to implementing information services of Pre-discovery, Discovery, Alpha, Beta. They currently cover the following areas:

a. Pre-Discovery

Capstone project to scope and define Defence Support Network IS.

b. Enterprise Architecture

Define and scope key Enterprise Architecture artefacts needed for DSN IS, as well as reviewing extant documentation.

c. Integration Services

Project to review current integration services and recommend approach to future integration.

d. Master Data Management & Data Quality

Project to review current capabilities, to identify list of key Master Data elements and sources and to recommend implementation approach.

e. User Story Development

Project to begin development of compelling user stories that will identify opportunities for early user benefit and digital delivery.
